2727 Reports from District and County Councillors

Cllr Barton (WSCC) reported that 1) WSCC have been granted £1.5m towards potholes repairs for West Sussex. 2) Trucks going to and from the former amenity site in Halewick Lane are taking away contaminated land and delivering new top soil until November 2018. Consider meeting with interested parties if thought necessary but keep under review. 3) Amenity site now open 7 days a week. 4) traffic survey being undertaken regarding A27 and non motorist crossing points. 5) Proposal to close Dankton Lane and Church Lane from A27 has not received the support of officers at WSCC.

Cllr Boggis (ADC) 1) Recent presentation by Persimmon Homes to ADC/WBC Major Projects Board re proposed housing development showing amendment to southern access to site. Further changes have been requested, awaiting further submission.2) SDNP developing an action plan for whole for former cement works site to attempt to avoid piecemeal development.

2728 WSCC Bus Consultation

Cllrs acknowledged some parts of Sompting are very badly served by current bus transport providers, particularly on Sundays. Encourage public to respond to bus consultation, deadline is 6.6.18. Clerk to post copies of consultation poster on bus stops, website and council noticeboards.

2729 WSCC A27 Non Motorised User (NMU) Consultation

Cllrs acknowledged this affected not only pedestrians but also cyclists, horse riders, mobility scooters etc. Cllr Godley suggested an under-pass at Dankton Lane as a solution. Agreed council would seek to improve the crossing at Hillbarn Lane traffic lights e.g. sounds on lights for pedestrians, phasing of traffic light sequence across junction etc. Clerk is asked to write to WSCC to see what immediate action can be taken.
