1043	Minutes of last meeting held on 23 rd October 2019: These were agreed and signed.	
1044	Halewick Lane – Agree date and arrangements for stakeholder meeting. A date is yet to be agreed – Assistant Clerk suggested a Friday evening when there is usually availability or the 3 rd Wednesday. Must be booked through Centre Manager.	
1045	Malthouse Meadow – Update by Cllr Glynn Davies. The bluebells have arrived and will be planted on 1st December together with the two trees. Another meeting will be held probably in January to discuss agreed objectives for Malthouse Meadow both short and long term. May try for protected space SSSI. Suggestions to introduce bat boxes and bird boxes. Maybe Men in Sheds could be involved. Maybe Epic could be approached to develop the wet area. SBL approached re noticeboard. Asst Clerk read out an e mail from ADC they confirmed that none of the council owned land has been sold. The land was conveyed to the Council to retain as public open space. Asst Clerk reported that the groundsman has been asked to take monthly photo updates. There is still no decision re sheep grazing.	
1046	Beggars Bush – Update by Cllr Glynn Davies. Had a meeting with Sompting Estate. Radical changes are needed in respect of ground works and prevention of fly tipping. Suggestions that only the upper car park is used. May be able to get funding for a gate. Any funding would have to come from 20/21 budget – and would have to be decided how much? Could an amount be match funded by the SDNP? Or could area be closely monitored by our conservation officer?.	

SIGNS - Update by Cllr Nicklen - As Cllr Nicklen was not at the

meeting this item was deferred to January 2020.

Traffic Issues – Update by Cllr Baxter

Speeding signs – Unfortunately some of the trial parking signs had been removed. Residents still thought they were a good idea.

Possible one way systems - Whitestyles Road – this has been deferred.

Test Road Pilot - anti parking initiative - Cllr Baxter to investigate further – happy to stand outside school and chat to parents. A letter to be drafted by Cllr Glynn Davies and approved by the Clerk from SPC to be distributed via the school noting the problem and citing the regulations and penalties. Clerk to give new PCSO details on the letter. Another suggestion maybe for sympathetic planting on the verges to prevent cars parking there; or actual planters

Football Club to pursue possibility of new pavilion

Recreation Ground toilets – need to know what is happening for the future – may be talk to ADC re lease.

Sompting in Bloom – should be for the whole of Sompting – not just from gardens – verges trees etc.

Hanging baskets on bus shelters –budget limitations - but ties in with Climate emergency

Noticeboards – to be checked for weeds growing around them.
